## Educreations directions

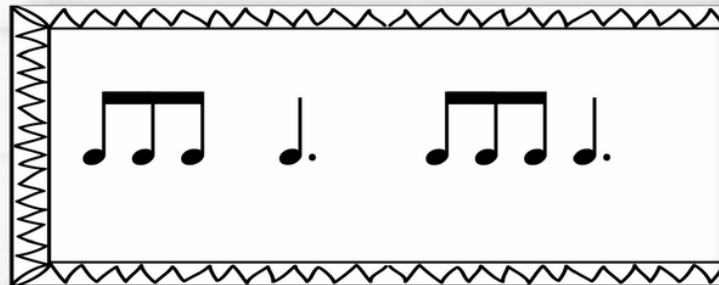
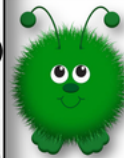
- Open up Educreations on the ipad. If someone has already gone before you, hit the arrow in the lower right corner to open up a new screen.

- Read each pattern for your teacher!



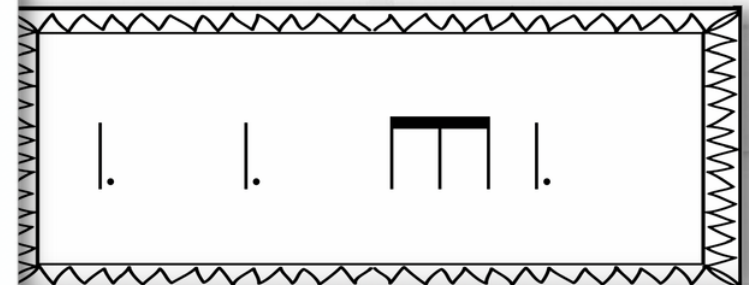

# CENTER SET : LINES & SPACES

## Staff directions

- Get a staff, five noteheads, and a do clef.
- Look at each stick notation card, and then write that on the staff, putting the do clef wherever you want. The extra time, do all the patterns again, but put it somewhere else!

## Staff jumping game directions

- Pick one person to be the "caller," and two people to jump.
- The caller calls out a bass clef line or space note, and the jumpers jump to that line or space. If calling out G or A, make sure to say "line G" or "space G" and "line A" or "space A." The first person on the correct line or space wins, and the best 2 out of 3 wins the round!
- After the round, a different person becomes the caller and two other people are chosen to jump.



## Staff Wars directions

- Get an ipad.
- Open "Staff Wars" app.
- Click the staff in the lower right until only notes on the staff are shown.
- Choose the bass clef.
- Choose start. Then click the right note!
- If the game is over, restart and keep playing until your time at that center is done.



## Directions

1. If someone has a win, they get a "gain." If someone has a loss, they get a "loss." The notes on the staff are moved to the lower right corner.

- Play the game, identifying notes as fast as you can!
- Hand the ipad to the next person!
- If everyone in your group has gotten a turn, then have everyone get a second turn as time allows.







# CENTER SET 3: LOW Ti CENTERS

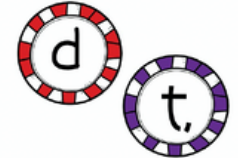
## Instrument center directions

- If you have time, then try playing with A being mi.

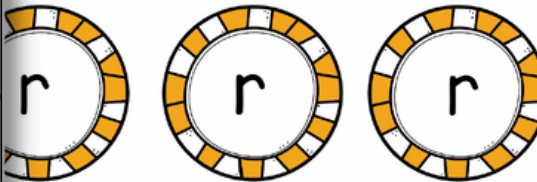


## Solfa manipulatives directions
